



CHAIR TOPPER OPERATION SAFETY

Safety First! Know that.... all the information contained in this manual is provided for your safety. Familiarity with proper operation instructions and maintenance procedures are necessary to ensure safe, trouble free operation. Safety precautions are provided to identify potentially hazardous situations and provide instructions on how to avoid them.

Safety Symbols:



This symbol indicates important safety information regarding a potentially hazardous situation that could result in serious bodily injury and/or property damage.

A CAUTION

This symbol indicates important information regarding how to avoid a hazardous situation that could result in minor personal injury or property damage.

Note: Additional information provided to help clarify or detail a specific subject.

These symbols will appear throughout this manual. Recognize the seriousness of this information.

CHAIR TOPPER SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

A WARNING

If the operating instructions, manual operating instructions and/or operation safety precautions are not fully understood, contact the Braun Corporation immediately. Failure to do so may result in serious bodily injury and/or property damage.

WARNING! With your dealers help, determine the optimum safe wheelchair position and wheelchair hook position before routine operation (refer to Pre-Installation Test Clearance Note 2 on page 5 in the Installation/Service Manual).

WARNING! Read manual before operating Chair Topper. Read and become familiar with all Safety Precautions, operating instructions and manual operating instructions before operating the Chair Topper.

WARNING! Provide adequate clearance outside the vehicle to accommodate the fully extended Chair Topper before operation.

WARNING! Open vehicle transfer door fully before operating Chair Topper.

WARNING! Properly position wheelchair at the predetermined position before transferring in and out of vehicle.

WARNING! Lock wheelchair brakes before transferring in and out of vehicle.

CHAIR TOPPER SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

WARNING! Insert wheelchair hook securely under the wheelchair seat (or in sewn pocket) at the predetermined position before raising wheelchair.

WARNING! Do not operate Chair Topper until the wheelchair occupant has transferred and is clear of the Chair Topper operating area.

WARNING! Stop wheelchair hook swinging motion before raising or lowering hook (with or without wheelchair).

WARNING! Inspect your Chair Topper before operation. Do not operate Chair Topper if you suspect damage, wear or any abnormal condition.

WARNING! Keep operator and bystanders clear of area in which the Chair Topper operates (clear of moving parts).

WARNING! Engage vehicle parking brake before operating Chair Topper.

WARNING! Load and unload clear of vehicular traffic.

WARNING! Load and unload on level surface only.

WARNING! Do not overload or abuse Chair Topper. The maximum wheelchair load rating is 45 lbs.

WARNING! Do not operate Chair Topper if you are intoxicated.

WARNING! Accidental activation of control switch(s) may cause unintended operation(s).

WARNING! Maintenance and lubrication procedures must be performed as specified in this manual by qualified (authorized) service personnel.

WARNING! Never modify (alter) a Braun Corporation Chair Topper.

WARNING! Do not use accessory devices not authorized by the Braun Corporation.

WARNING! Do not remove any guards or covers.

WARNING! Replace missing, worn or illegible decals.

WARNING! Keep owner's manual in Chair Topper equipped vehicle at all times.

WARNING! Manually support wheelchair when manually lowering the wheelchair (wheelchair hook will free-fall when secondary unfold motor sprocket disengages from shaft sprocket).

WARNING! Failure to follow these safety precautions may result in serious bodily injury and/or property damage.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

TO LOAD:


1. Open the door fully and transfer from the wheelchair to the vehicle (the wheelchair brakes should be locked for safety).

Note: Leave the wheelchair remaining completely unfolded and facing forward (toward the front of the vehicle).

2. Press the control toggle switch to DOWN to open the Chair Topper fully and unfold the "fold" frame. Release the switch momentarily.

Press the control toggle switch to DOWN and carefully lower the chair hook to the desired height (to check hook and chair positioning). Release switch.

3. Refer to FIGURE 1. With the wheelchair remaining fully unfolded and properly positioned, insert the hook securely under the wheelchair seat. Carefully position such that the hook is aligned with the center of the wheelchair seat and is in alignment with the predetermined alignment point.



4. Press the control toggle switch to UP to raise the wheelchair.

A CAUTION

Be certain no swinging motion is occurring.

Continue to press the switch to UP to fold the frame and wheelchair, stow chair, and close Chair Topper fully. Release switch.

Note: If the Chair Topper fails to open using the hand control, refer to pages 5 and 6 for Manual Unfold Instructions.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



TO UNLOAD:

- 1. Open the door fully.
- 2. Press the control toggle switch to DOWN to open the Chair Topper and unfold the "fold" frame and wheelchair fully.

A CAUTION

Release switch momentarily to ensure no swinging motion or any potentially dangerous conditions exist.

Press switch to DOWN and carefully lower wheelchair to ground level. Release switch.

- 3. Remove hook from wheelchair.
- 4. Press the toggle switch to UP to raise hook.

A CAUTION

Be certain no swinging motion is occurring.


Continue to press switch to UP to close Chair Topper fully. Release switch.

Note: If the Chair Topper fails to open using the hand control, refer to pages 5 and 6 for Manual Unfold Instructions.

MANUAL UNFOLD INSTRUCTIONS - PRIMARY

Note: An attendant will be required to perform the manual unfolding procedures.

- 1. Refer to FIGURE 2. Open the vehicle door fully, and open the access door on the stationary side of the Chair Topper.
- 2. Refer to FIGURE 3. Pull the hairpin out of the Quick Release Knob. Turn the Quick Release Knob in a counterclockwise direction as shown, until the motor sprocket disengages from the sprocket on the main drive shaft.
- 3. Refer to FIGURE 2. Carefully extend the roller frame by manually pulling it out from the loading side.




MANUAL UNFOLD INSTRUCTIONS - SECONDARY

4. Refer to FIGURE 4. Pull the hairpin out of the Quick Release Knob. Manually hold the wheelchair up while turning the Quick Release Knob in a counterclockwise direction as shown, until the motor sprocket disengages from the sprocket on the shaft.

A WARNING

The wheelchair must be manually lowered as the shaft will freewheel when the sprockets are disengaged. To prevent injury, or damage to the chair, be prepared to support the full weight of the chair when the sprockets disengage.

5. Carefully lower the wheelchair to ground level.



MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE



WARNING

Press DOWN switch to deploy Chair Topper fully and then disconnect the red 12 gauge power wire at the battery prior to servicing, (checks, repairs, lubrication, clearing of obstructions, etc.)

Perform maintenance at the scheduled intervals according to the number of cycles or elapsed time, whichever comes first. Contact your sales representative or call the Braun Corporation at 1-800-THE LIFT if you have any questions.

4 WEEKS OR 100 CYCLES

All bearings: inspect for wear

Light oil (30 weight or equivalent)

Fold linkage pivot points

Light oil

Debris – obstructions

Remove and clean

Bearing mounting hardware: inspect for proper securement Correct or replace

Pop rivets (securing mounting

Replace or resecure as needed

feet): inspect to see if worn or missing

Mounting hardware (frame and Topper securement): inspect to make sure there are no loose or missing parts

Replace, tighten or resecure as

needed

3 MONTHS OR 300 CYCLES

Repeat all checks listed in the 4 weeks or 100 cycles section Repeat maintenance procedures

All mounting hardware (securing framework, bearings, linkage, motors, etc.): inspect for loose, damaged or missing parts

Replace, tighten, adjust or realign

as needed

Chains: inspect for lubrication, damage, misalignment, binding

Light oil – Note: Clean before lubricating – realign or correct any other conditions as needed

MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

3 MONTHS OR 300 CYCLES

Chain bolts and all chain connecting points: inspect master links and chain blocks for positive securement and/or possible damage Replace, resecure or correct as needed

Sprockets: inspect for securement, slippage, alignment or any damage

Replace, realign or resecure as needed

Chain channels (plastic): inspect for damage, securement or obstructions

Clean, correct or replace

Chain boxes (up/down chain enclosure): inspect for obstructions or damage

Clean or correct

Side bearing channels (2): inspect for damage, securement or obstructions

Clean, resecure or correct as needed

Main wiring harness: inspect for possible damage, securement or poor electrical connections

Correct, resecure or repair as needed

Control harness: inspect for possible damage, securement or poor electrical connections

Correct, resecure or repair as needed

Power cable: inspect for damage or poor connections

Correct or replace as needed

Ground wires: inspect for damage, securement or poor connections

Correct, resecure or repair as needed

Fold springs: inspect to see if detached or worn

Correct or replace

Fold linkage: inspect for excessive wear, damage, lubrication and securement

Light oil, resecure or realign as needed

Pop rivets (securing ABS plastic shell): inspect to see if worn or missing

Replace or resecure as needed

MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

1 YEAR OR 1250 CYCLES (GENERAL INSPECTION)

Repeat all checks listed in the two (2) previous sections Repeat maintenance procedures

Circuit breaker: inspect securement

and electrical connections

Correct as needed

Microswitches (2): inspect for possible damage, securement or poor electrical connections

Replace, resecure or correct wiring connections as needed

Relays/relay blocks: inspect for possible damage, securement or poor electrical connections

Replace, resecure or correct wiring connections as needed

Seals and gaskets: inspect to see if damaged, worn or missing

Correct as needed

Decals: inspect

Replace if worn, missing or




Internal moisture (from use during rain or snow)


Leave open on dry day to dry interior

Note: The ABS plastic shell may be washed and/or waxed in the same manner in which you care for your vehicle.





Braun "Worry-Free" Three-Year Limited Warranty

The Braun Corporation of Winamac, Indiana, warrants its Chair Topper against defects in material and workmanship for three years, providing the Chair Topper is operated and maintained properly and in conformity with this manual. This warranty is limited to the original purchaser and does not cover defects in the motor vehicle on which it is installed, or defects in the Chair Topper caused by a defect in any part of the motor vehicle.

This warranty commences on the date the Chair Topper is put in service, providing the warranty registration card is completed and received by The Braun Corporation within 20 days of purchase.

This warranty also covers the cost of labor for the repair or replacement of most parts for one year when performed by an authorized Braun Representative. (A Braun labor schedule determines cost allowance for repairs.)

This warranty does not cover normal maintenance, service, or periodic adjustments necessitated by use or wear. The Braun Corporation will not, under any circumstances, pay for loss of use of Chair Topper or vehicle in which it is installed or loss of time.

This warranty will become null and void if the Chair Topper has been damaged through accident, misuse, or neglect, or if the Chair Topper has been altered in any respect.
